Possible Effects of Repeated Overexposure

Chronic Overexposure May Cause Pneumoconiosis (dusty lungs)

-No Known Hazard-

Emergency and First Aid Procedures

<u>INHALATION</u>	Remove to fresh air. If breathing is difficult, oxygen and call a physician
<u>SKIN CONTACT</u>	Of no general concern. Simply wash with soap and water.
<u>EYE CONTACT</u>	For acute exposure, flush with water. IF irritation or discomfort persists, call a physician.
<u>INGESTION</u>	No Known Hazard.

Notes to Physician

There are no specific antidotes to acute overexposure. Treatment should be directed at control of the symptoms.
